Directions:

Our actual property address is 986 Rockport Road, Hackettstown, NJ. But for GPS purposes use 977 Rockport Road for our main driveway (Look for the mailbox with 986-983 on it). There are round bales along the road to the southwest of our driveway. The entrance to the handler parking field is about 800 feet down Rockport Road to the southwest from our driveway.

MOST IMPORTANT for RV's. If you are using Route 80, your GPS may direct you to take exit 19 down to the center of Hackettstown and out Grand Avenue (which turns into Rockport Road). This is fine for cars and pickups. But, there is a railroad overpass on that road with a 10'-8" clearance. So, if you are coming east on 80 and are taller than 10'-8", you should take exit 4B to Route 46 east to Route 31 south to Route 57 east in Washington. Follow 57 and make a left onto Airport Road (traffic light right after you enter the 35mph zone in Beattystown) which dead ends on Rockport Road. Take a right on Rockport and the entrance to the handler parking field will be on your left about a half mile from Airport Rd.

If you are coming west on 80 in an RV taller than 10'-8", you should take exit 26 to Route 46 west. Follow Route 46 and turn left on East Avenue (there's a traffic light there and just past the Honda dealer). At the end of East, turn left onto Mountain Avenue and a right onto Route 57 west (just past Berk's Furniture). Follow 57 past the Walmart and turn right onto Airport Road, a right onto Rockport and a left into the handler parking field. For cars and pickups coming west on 80, it's okay to take exit 19 down to the center of Hackettstown and out Grand Avenue (which turns into Rockport Road).

FOR ALL VEHICLES

If you're coming east on 78, the easiest way is to take exit 16 and follow the signs to Route 31 west. Take 31 west for about 7 miles to the Asbury-Anderson Road (traffic light right past the McDonalds on the left). Take that for a bit over 3 miles and bear right onto Route 57. Follow 57 and make a left onto Airport Road (traffic light right after you enter the 35mph zone in Beattystown) which dead ends on Rockport Road. Take a right on Rockport and the entrance to the handler parking field will be on your left about a half mile from Airport. There are no low bridges on this route, so cars and RVs can follow the same route.

If you're coming west on 78, take exit 17 and follow the signs to Route 31 west and then follow the directions above.
